Resolution – Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office Grant Application for Body-Worn Cameras

Consider, approve, and authorize the attached Resolution relating to the FY2027 Body-Worn Cameras funding opportunity, regarding Brazoria County's request for financial assistance from the Office of the Governor's Public Safety Office.

Further, the County Judge is hereby authorized to act as Brazoria County's Authorized Official and sign any documentation related to the application for the Grant upon review by the District Attorney's Office.

Resolution

WHEREAS, The Brazoria County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Brazoria County that Brazoria County law enforcement agencies be equipped with body-worn cameras and rifle-resistant body armor for the Fiscal Year 2027; and

WEAREAS, The Brazoria County Commissioners Court agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the FY2027 Body-Worn Cameras grant application; and

WHEREAS, The Brazoria County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Brazoria County's Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, The Brazoria County Commissioners Court designates The Brazoria County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS, The Brazoria County Commissioners Court designates The Brazoria County auditor as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that The Brazoria County Commissioners Court approves the submission of the grant applications for Body-Worn Cameras FY27 and Rifle-Resistant Body Armor FY27 to the Office of the Governor.
