

**AMENDMENT TO PUBLIC SERVICES AGREEMENT
BETWEEN BRAZORIA COUNTY
AND
ActionS, Inc. of Brazoria County**

WHEREAS on May 12, 2026 the Brazoria County Commissioner’s Court at its regular Commissioner’s Court meeting approved an amendment to the 2025 Annual Action Plan increasing funding to the ActionS of Brazoria County Meals 2025 CDBG public services project; and

WHEREAS on May 12, 2026, the Brazoria County Commissioner’s Court at its regular Court meeting approved an amendment to the Public Services Agreement between ActionS, Inc. of Brazoria County and Brazoria County as follows:

Page 1, Section I. Scope of Service, shall be amended to read as follows:

The Subrecipient will be responsible for administering a public service program in a manner satisfactory to the Grantee and consistent with any standards required as a condition of providing these funds and in accordance with their application for assistance, which shall be considered a part of this agreement as if fully set forth. Such program will include the following activities approved under the 2025 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Action Plan:

ActionS Inc. of Brazoria County will assist approximately 120 low- to moderate income elderly persons throughout Brazoria County in the Homebound Meals program. The CDBG funds will be utilized for providing meals to Brazoria County Senior (62 years or older) residents.

Page 1, Section III. Goals and Performance Measures shall be amended to read as follows:

The Subrecipient will assist 120 low- to moderate income persons with enhanced suitable living environment by providing homebound meals to elderly residents of Brazoria County. This will allow a more Suitable Living Environment through Availability/Accessibility.

Page 2, Section VI – Grant Amount, shall be amended to read as follows:

It is expressly understood that the maximum total amount to be paid by Grantee under this Agreement shall be Thirty-two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars and No Cents (\$32,750.00), or the amount received from HUD, whichever is less. Furthermore, it is expressly understood by Subrecipient that Grantee’s obligation under this Agreement is conditioned upon receipt of such funds from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. It is expressly agreed and understood that the total amount to be paid by the Grantee under this contract shall not exceed Thirty-two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars and No Cents (\$32,750.00). Payment of eligible expenses shall be made against the line item budgets specified in Paragraph VII herein and in accordance with performance and applicable program requirements.

Page 2, Section VII - Budget, shall be amended to read as follows:
