Reason: Attendance at *Healthcare Leadership for Mass Casualty Incidents (MGT-901)* will directly strengthen Brazoria County's all-hazards disaster preparedness and healthcare surge coordination capabilities. This FEMA-funded course focuses on mass casualty leadership, Hospital Incident Command System integration, medical surge planning, interagency coordination, supply distribution, and risk communication during CBRNE incidents, natural disasters, and pandemics. As PHEP Manager, this training will enhance my ability to coordinate healthcare partners, integrate public health into unified command structures, and lead response efforts during large-scale incidents. It has been strongly recommended that I complete this training prior to the World Cup events in June–July to ensure our county is fully prepared for potential surge and mass casualty scenarios. The course is fully funded by FEMA, resulting in no cost to the County.
