On behalf of Brazoria County Commissioners Court, I am writing to express our strong support for the Community Project Funding request submitted by **Stephen F. Austin Community Health Center, dba Community Health Network (MYCHN)** for the development of the **MyCHN Freeport Women and Children's Health Center** in Freeport, Texas.

This request will support the development of an innovative healthcare facility dedicated to expanding access to comprehensive services for women, children, and families in Brazoria County. The proposed **9,000-square-foot MyCHN Freeport Women and Children's Health Center** will provide an integrated model of care that includes pediatric primary care, women's health services, behavioral health, pediatric dental services, pharmacy services, and a child-focused development and engagement area designed to improve the patient experience for families.

Importantly, the project will also support the **expansion of Maternal-Fetal Medicine services**, improving access to specialized care for high-risk pregnancies in the region. Expanding these services locally will help ensure that expectant mothers with complex medical needs can receive coordinated prenatal care closer to home, reducing barriers to care and improving maternal and infant health outcomes.

MyCHN currently serves as a critical healthcare provider for families in the Freeport area and ensures access to quality care continues along the Texas Gulf Coast. Access to maternal and pediatric healthcare services remains a significant need. The development of the MyCHN Freeport Women and Children's Health Center will significantly strengthen the healthcare infrastructure in Brazoria County and expand access to essential services for women and children. Federal investment through Community Project Funding will help ensure that families in Texas' 14th Congressional District have access to high-quality, integrated healthcare services close to home. For these reasons, we respectfully urge you to support this request and include it among your priorities for Fiscal Year 2027 appropriations.
