## Agreement on Identification of Future Transportation Corridors Within Brazoria County

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) on February 5, 2024, received a request from Brazoria County to enter into an agreement under Transportation Code, Section 201.619, to identify future transportation corridors within Brazoria County based on transportation plans developed by the Houston-Galveston Area Council.

TxDOT has reviewed the request and all supporting information provided by Brazoria County and has determined that the future transportation corridors identified in the request, denoted as "major thoroughfare, existing"; "major thoroughfare, proposed"; "major collector, existing"; and "major collector, proposed" in the 2020 Brazoria County Thoroughfare Plan map dated August 22, 2020, are derived from existing transportation plans adopted by Brazoria County on August 11, 2020.

Brazoria County and TxDOT agree, in accordance with Transportation Code, Section 201.619, that the corridors depicted in the attachment to this agreement represent future transportation corridors within Brazoria County and that those corridors are derived from existing transportation plans adopted by Brazoria County on August 11, 2020. The corridors depicted in the attachment align with TxDOT's current long-range transportation plans.

Brazoria County agrees to work cooperatively with an owner of land that is subject to the plat requirements of Local Government Code, Section 232.0033, to establish the centerline and appropriate corridor width of the transportation facilities that are being developed in a transportation corridor identified in this agreement in which all or part of the owner's land is located.

This agreement is a planning agreement that is solely for the purposes of Transportation Code, Section 201.619. This agreement does not obligate or prevent future adjustments by either party to the corridors identified in the agreement. Any significant revision to the location of one or more of those corridors will require an amendment to this agreement or a revised agreement to ensure compliance with Section 201.619.
