Waste Connections would like to sincerely thank you for the great opportunity we have had to serve the citizens and community of Manvel. We thoroughly enjoy and appreciate the relationship between Waste Connections and the City of Manvel.

Each year we evaluate the CPI-U and fuel costs per our contract with the city. This year the CPI-U adjustment is 3.5% and the fuel adjustment is .56% for a total adjustment of 4.06%. I have enclosed further details of these adjustments with this letter.

We would like to adjust these rates on the June billing cycle.
