

**Amendment No. 1**  
For INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT  
Related to GLO State Contract Number 20-065-118-C388

THIS AMENDMENT, MADE THIS 1 OF MAY 2026 BY AND BETWEEN CITY OF BRAZORIA, hereinafter referred to as the City, and BRAOZIA COUNTY, hereinafter referred to as the County.

Description of Amendment:

1) This amendment replaces Section III OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY as follows:

3. Permit unrestricted access by the County, and its selected engineering, and administrative contractors, or any other individual requested by the County, to those portions of the construction site under City control, to allow performance of all duties, obligations, and rights outlined or authorized by the Grant for the Grant Project and/or as required in agreements these entities, agencies, or contractors shall have with the County related to the Grant Project.

2) This amendment includes the following additional items under Section III OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY.

10. The City of Brazoria shall be responsible for the procurement of a construction contractor to complete the project as identified in the approved bid schedule.

11. The City of Brazoria shall comply with all applicable procurement requirements, including but not limited to those set forth in 2 C.F.R. §§ 200.318–200.326, as well as all other federal, state, and local procurement laws, regulations, and rules. The City shall verify that all selected vendors and subcontractors are not debarred or suspended from receiving state or federal funds by consulting the following resources:

12. The City of Brazoria shall comply with the Davis–Bacon Act, together with all other applicable federal, state, and local requirements governing labor standards, procurement, and contract administration.

13. The City acknowledges that all payments will be issued by the Texas General Land Office (GLO) to Brazoria County, and that the County will remit payment to the City of Brazoria upon receipt of funds from the GLO.

14. The City acknowledges that once payment is received, the City has 3 business days to pay the appropriate vendors.

All other terms and conditions of the INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT between the City of Brazoria and Brazoria County will remain in full force and effect.
