WHEREAS, E. Viola & Son Funeral Home, established in 1936 by Emile Viola, faithfully served the West Columbia community and Brazoria County for eighty-nine (89) years, providing compassionate care and dignified services to families during their most difficult times; and

WHEREAS, Emile Viola, a skilled carpenter and blacksmith, built the funeral home himself and laid the foundation for a multigenerational family business rooted in service, integrity, and community trust; and

WHEREAS, the funeral home was later owned and operated by Traversia and Kathryn Viola, and subsequently by their daughter, Marilyn Vern Smith, who became the final owner and manager who carried forward the family legacy following the passing of her relatives; and

WHEREAS, the decision to close the funeral home in April 2025 was made with great difficulty due to staffing challenges and changing circumstances, marking the end of an era for a business deeply woven into the fabric of the community; and

WHEREAS, E. Viola & Son Funeral Home was widely respected for its professionalism, altruism and meticulous record-keeping. Its historic records have been entrusted to the Varner-Hogg Plantation State Historical Site to preserve local history for future generations; and




NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the Commissioners Court of Brazoria County, Texas, hereby honors and recognizes



for their eighty-nine years of devoted service to Brazoria County, and we expresses our sincere appreciation for their lasting contributions to the lives, history, and well-being of the community.




