JUVENILE JUSTICE YOUTH DIVERSION GRANT PROGRAM FY 2027

GRANT PROGRAM NUMBER 5719301

WHEREAS, The Brazoria County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Brazoria County, that the Project G.R.O.W. (Guidance, Responsibility, Opportunity, Wellness) be operated for the FY2027; and

WHEREAS, Brazoria County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Brazoria County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, Brazoria County Commissioners Court designates the County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, Brazoria County Commissioners Court designates the County Auditor as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Brazoria County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the Project G.R.O.W. (Guidance, Responsibility, Opportunity, Wellness) to the Office of the Governor.
