RE: Home Investment Partnerships Program – American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) and HOME- Community Housing Development Organization (HOME-CHDO) Program- Advertise Request for Applications (RFA) and Appoint Committee

<u>Background:</u> Brazoria County has received \$1.4 million in HOME Investment Partnerships- American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) funding and \$248,390.25 in HOME Community Housing Development Organization (HOME-CHDO) funding. Purpose of funding is to increase availability of affordable housing and/or noncongregate shelter, tenant based rental assistance, and supportive services for qualifying populations at risk of or experiencing homelessness. Qualified housing developers and non-profits may apply to receive grants to carry out these activities.

To review applications and select grant awards, it is recommended that a committee be appointed.
