PROCLAMATION

Child abuse prevention occurs every day through the diligent work, tireless advocacy, and simple acts of kindness undertaken by Brazoria County families, friends, neighbors, houses of faith, advocacy groups, nonprofit organizations, schools, health-care providers, social workers, and government agencies to support children and families in every community across Brazoria County; and

Behind many families that succeeded on their own is a strong community that provided a way for the family to meet their needs. All citizens of Brazoria County must work together to strengthen our communities and build localized supports that are accessible, contribute to the well-being of the entire community, and keep children and families safe and together.
