

26-50 Award Summary

A total of two hundred and sixty-nine (269) vendors were notified of the solicitation, which was posted in the Bonfire electronic procurement portal, as well as posted on the Electronic Business Daily (ESBD) website and advertised in the Facts. There were twenty-seven (27) document takers resulting in three (3) submissions.

Upon recommendation of the Purchasing Department, award "ITB# 26-50 Mosquito Control Chemicals" to the following vendors, who submitted the best bids meeting our specifications.

- ADAPCO, LLC of Lake Mary, FL
- Rentokil North America Inc., dba Target Specialty Products of Baton Rouge, LA
- ES OPCO USA LLC dba Vesperis of Austin, TX

On line six of the attached bid tabulation, the product Vectobac 12AS contains a higher concentration of active ingredient compared to Fallout LQ, despite Fallout LQ being the lowest-priced option. Because Fallout LQ would require a greater volume of product per acre to achieve the desired efficacy, it would not represent the best long-term value. Therefore, it is recommended to select Vectobac 12AS due to its higher active ingredient concentration and overall cost-effectiveness.

On line nine of the attached bid tabulation, the lowest two proposed bidders' products are not compatible with current equipment used for disbursement. Modifying the current equipment to achieve compatibility would not be cost-effective. Therefore, the line was awarded to the sole vendor that submitted a compatible product.

Per local government code 262.027(b) if two responsible bidders submit the lowest and best, commissioners court shall decide between the two by drawing lots in a manner prescribed by the County Judge. It is requested that the Judge pull lots for the award of lines eight (8) and ten (10) of the attached bid tabulation as they are the result of a tie. The results of which need to be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.
