## RFSQ# 24-36 Award Summary

A total of ten thousand eighty-two (10082) vendors were notified of our solicitation which was posted in our Bonfire electronic procurement portal as well as advertised in The Facts and the Electronic State Business Daily (EBSD) website. There were one hundred and fifty-one (151) document takers resulting in six (6) responsive submissions.
