OPERATION STONEGARDEN

WHEREAS, The BRAZORIA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Brazoria County, that the Operation Stonegarden Grant Program be operated for 2026; and

WHEREAS, The Brazoria County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the Brazoria County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, The Brazoria County Commissioners Court designates the Brazoria County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, The Brazoria County Commissioners Court designates the Brazoria County Auditor as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Brazoria County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the Operation Stonegarden Grant Program to the Office of the Governor.
