

## RFP #26-24 Award Summary

A total of one hundred and eleven (111) vendors were notified of our solicitation which was posted on the Bonfire electronic procurement portal, as well as posted on the Electronic Business Daily (ESBD) website and advertised in The Facts. There were twenty-nine (29) document takers resulting in four (4) submissions.

Upon review of the bids received, award "ITB #26-24 Waste Management Services-Port-A-Cans" to Texla Rental Services LLC of Vidor, Texas who submitted the best bid meeting our specifications as per the attached overall pricing.

In addition, the apparent low bidder, United Site Services of Texas, Inc. of Old Ocean, Texas, submitted exceptions to Sections 3.6 and 3.7 of the Specifications. These exceptions would have shifted liability to Brazoria County for theft, disappearance, or certain types of damage, which directly contradicts the solicitation's requirement that the vendor remain fully responsible for damaged, vandalized, or missing units.

After review, the District Attorney's Office determined that these exceptions materially altered the mandatory terms of the bid documents and were therefore not acceptable. As a result, the bid from United Site Services of Texas, Inc. was deemed non-responsive.
