BRAZORIA COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN 2023

WHEREAS, Brazoria County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Brazoria County has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Brazoria County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2023 in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY BRAZORIA COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:



ADOPTED by vote of Brazoria County's Commissioners Court this 13th day August, 2024.






