WHEREAS, the telecommunicators employed at the Brazoria County Sheriff's Office, answer those calls for assistance and serve as the first contact our citizens have with emergency services; and

WHEREAS, the safety of police officers, firefighters, and paramedics that serve our citizens is dependent on the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who use the 9-1-1 system; and

WHEREAS, on October 9, 1991 the Congress of the United States proclaimed the second week of April as 'National Public Safety Telecommunicator Week'.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Brazoria County does hereby proclaim April 13, 2025 to April 19, 2025 as


in Brazoria County and urge the appropriate recognition whereof.






