Ms. Fox,

After Mr. Sanchez' conversation with you concerning the City of Lake Jackson terminating the City's participation in the County's On-Site Employee Medical and Wellness Clinic Provider, I brought the decision to terminate the Interlocal Agreement to City Council. On July 7, 2025, City Council agreed to terminate the Agreement. Mr. Sanchez informed you of that decision by email on July 18<sup>th</sup>. Upon your July 28<sup>th</sup> request for a council resolution, Mr. Sanchez sent you the July 7<sup>th</sup> City Council minutes that showed City Council unanimous vote to terminate the participation. On July 30<sup>th</sup>, you requested a formal termination letter.

Due to the prior emails and minutes sent, as of July 18, 2025, the City of Lake Jackson has invoked the 60-day termination notice required in Article II of the Interlocal Agreement Between the City Of Lake Jackson and Brazoria County for the Provision of Medical Services. Further, as also required in Article II, City Council has not appropriated sufficient funds to satisfy its obligations under the Agreement.

The Agreement will terminate on September 30, 2025.

Thank you for the opportunity to share the use of the clinic, it has been a great relationship.
