Permission is requested for to attend the Indiana University – Robert Borkenstein Alcohol Course. The conference will be held from May 12 – 17, 2024 in Bloomington, Indiana. The Borkenstein course is the preeminent alcohol analyst training course. The course will explore the relationship between alcohol use and driving. An international panel of experts will discuss the pharmacology, toxicology and human performance effects of alcohol associated with driving impairment. The majority of alcohol analysts testifying in Texas have attended the course. Previously, the course was offered online but has moved back to in-person since the end of the pandemic.
